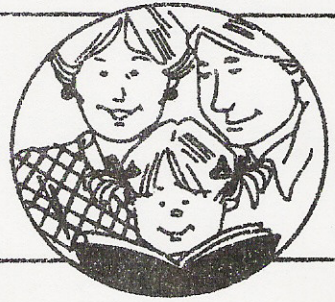


## Reading Together

Pumpkin pie, pumpkin pie?

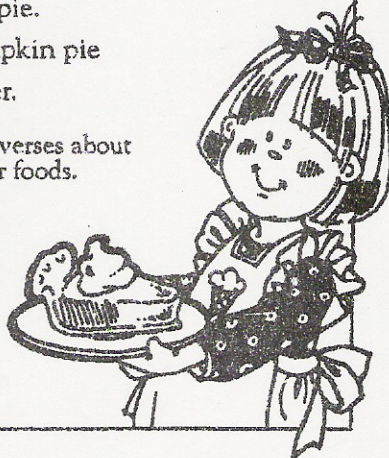

other Thanksgiving dinner foods.

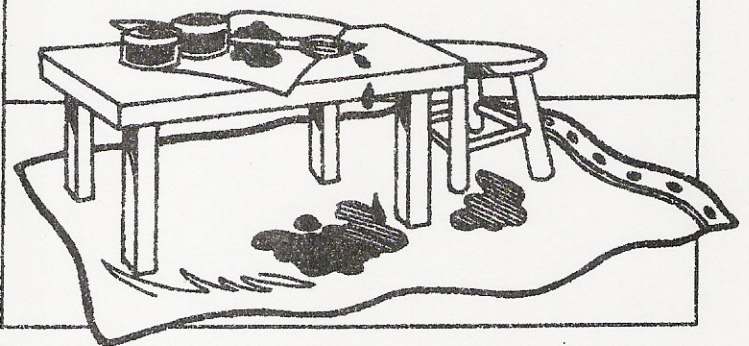

## Mess Catcher

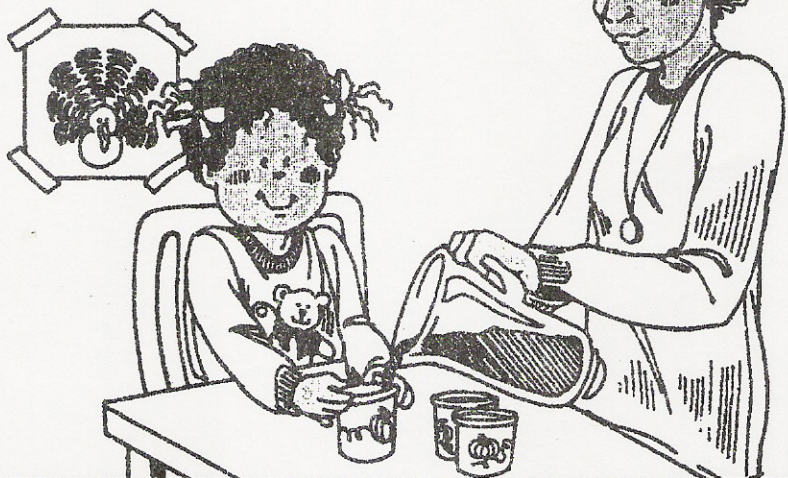
Put an old shower curtain under your child's work

## Orange Fluff

Pour  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup water into a bowl and add  
2 envelopes of unflavored gelatin. Stir  
and let set for 5 minutes. Add  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup  
boiling water and stir until gelatin is  
dissolved. Pour mixture into a blender  
and add 1 can (6 ounces) orange-juice  
concentrate. Blend until fluffy, then  
pour into small cups. Chill for about  
15 minutes. Makes 6 small servings.
